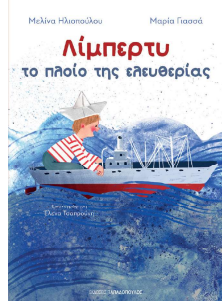

**The Only Child** H/C, 32pp, 23x28cm



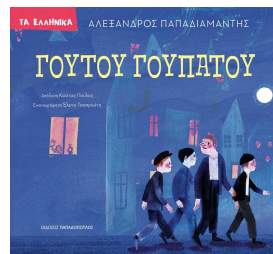

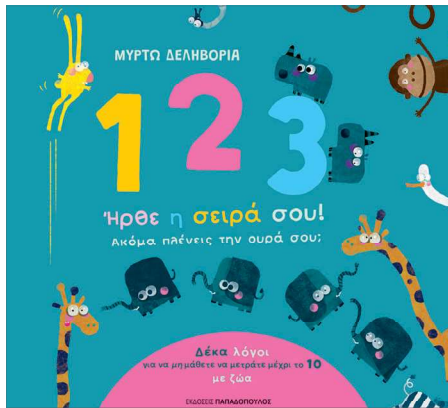

A story about dealing with bullying, embracing difference, and the value of loving yourself—and others. Because we can indeed live in harmony and celebrate our differences.



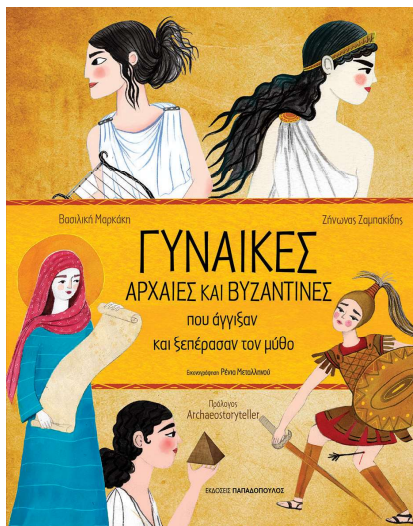
